in conjunction with the Hungarian Sailing Federation

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 For the 29er Euro Cup, the [Notice of Series](#) of the 29er Euro Cup Series shall apply.
- 1.3 RRS Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42, shall apply.
- 1.4 RRS Appendix T, Arbitration, shall apply.
- 1.5 The national authority prescriptions that apply are stated in full at [this link](#).
- 1.6 **[DP]** RRS 40.1 shall apply at all times while afloat.
- 1.7 RRS 44.1 and P2.1 are changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.
- 1.8 RRS 90.3(e) shall apply.
- 1.9 If there is a conflict between languages the English text takes precedence.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available at the official notice board no later than the start of registration.

3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The official notice board is available via the <https://www.byc.hu/versenyek/2024-high-performance-gp/> website.
- 3.2 Notices may also be posted on the notice board located at the entrance of the Balatonfüredi Yacht Club.
- 3.3 **[DP]** While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY AND REGISTRATION

- 4.1 For the 29er Euro Cup and 2024 Hungarian Championship:
- The event is open to all boats of the International 29er Class.
 - Each competitor shall be a member of the International 29er Class Association.
 - Each competitor shall be 13 years old before 31 December 2024.
- 4.2 For the Nacra 15 Ranking Regatta, the event is open to all boats of the Nacra 15 class.
- 4.3 Competitors of Hungarian nationality shall be holders of their 2024 competition licence issued by the Hungarian Sailing Federation (HSF).
- 4.4 Eligible boats may enter as follows:
- Boats with all crew members holding their 2024 competition licence issued by the HSF: in the VIHAR system of the HSF.
 - Other boats: by completing the entry form at <https://www.byc.hu/versenyek/2024-high-performance-gp/>.
- 4.5 Registration: at the race office located in the clubroom of the Balatonfüredi Yacht Club (8230 Balatonfüred, Zákonyi Ferenc u. 2.),
- for the 29er Euro Cup and 2024 Hungarian Championship: between 18:00-20:00 on 18 September 2024.
 - for the Nacra 15 Ranking Regatta: between 17:00-18:00 on 20 September 2024.
- 4.6 Each competitor not holding their 2024 competition licence issued by the HSF under 18 years old on 28 September 2024 shall bring to registration a completed parent/guardian consent form. The form is available at the official notice board.
- 4.7 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees no later than at registration.

5. FEES

- 5.1 The entry fee for each boat will be as follows:

Class	Early bird entry fee	Entry fee
29er	55,000 HUF	60,000 HUF
Nacra 15	30,000 HUF	36,000 HUF

Only boats entering by 23:59 on 13 September 2024 will be eligible for the early bird entry fee.

- 5.2 Entry fees shall be paid by bank transfer (only in HUF currency) before registration, or by cash or credit/debit cards at registration. Details of the bank transfer are the following:

- 5.3 Entry fees may also be paid in EUR currency at registration, based on the daily exchange rate.



6. [DP] IDENTIFICATION AND ADVERTISING

- 6.1 When provided by the organizing authority, boats or competitors shall carry, display or wear the following as instructed:
- coloured bibs for leaders (1st, 2nd and 3rd), and
 - event advertising.

7. SCHEDULE

- 7.1 Racing days, scheduled time of warning signals and number of races:

- 7.2 On the last scheduled day of racing (22 September 2024) no warning signal will be made after 14:00.

8. EQUIPMENT

- 8.1 Each boat shall produce or verify the existence of a valid measurement certificate at registration.
- 8.2 All boats are required to comply with RRS 78.1 from 60 minutes before the scheduled time of their first warning signal onwards. Non-compliance from this time until the start of the first race shall be reported, protested and penalized as if it were discovered after racing on the first day on which races for that boat have been completed.
- 8.3 Penalties for breaches of class rules and RRS 50 may, at the discretion of the protest committee be less than disqualification.

9. VENUE

- 9.1 The event venue will be the port of the Balatonfüredi Yacht Club. The address of the port: 8230 Balatonfüred, Zákonyi Ferenc u. 2.
- 9.2 The racing areas will be the waters among Balatonfüred, Alsóörs, Siófok, Zamárdi and Tihany.

10. THE COURSES

- 10.1 Windward-leeward courses will be sailed.

11. INTERNATIONAL JURY

11.1 An international jury will be appointed in accordance with RRS 91(b). Its decisions will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.

12. SCORING

12.1 For the 29er Euro Cup, three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

12.2 For the 2024 29er Hungarian Championship, four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

12.3 For the Nacra 15 Ranking Regatta, one race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

12.4 (a) When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When four or more races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12.5 Ranking of the 2024 29er Hungarian Championship will be determined by extracting boats (without recalculation) from the overall results of the 29er Euro Cup that are eligible for a national championship title.

13. SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

13.1 For the purposes of these instructions a support person vessel is any vessel with support persons aboard.

13.2 Lake Balaton is a natural preservation area and the use of powerboats is strictly regulated by Hungarian law. Only boats with proper permits may be used as support person vessels for the event. Failure to obtain these permits may result in prosecution by the local authorities. There will be a limited number of temporary permits available for support person vessels. In order to obtain one, support person vessels shall initially register by 23:59 on 8 September 2024. To register, please contact the organizing authority for information regarding data to be submitted, fees and the content of the permit.

13.3 Support person vessels shall be registered by their drivers during registration. The registered driver(s) of a support person vessel will be responsible for the control of the vessel at all times and will be held responsible for any inappropriate behaviour or dangerous actions, or actions affecting the fairness or safety of competition.

13.4 Each support person vessel shall submit the sail numbers of the supported boats at registration; each boat shall belong to a support person vessel. A support person vessel may support no more than ten boats.

13.5 Each support person vessel shall clearly display an identification number supplied at registration. A minimum deposit of 4,000 HUF or 10 EUR will be required for the identification number.

- 13.6 A team leaders meeting will be held 2 hours before the scheduled time of the first warning signal each day.
- 13.7 Each support person vessel is strongly recommended to carry a VHF radio on board.
- 13.8 Each support person vessel driver and each crew member on board shall wear a personal flotation device or a life jacket at all times while they are afloat with the engine of their support person vessel running.
- 13.9 It is mandatory that the kill cord is used at all times when the engine is running.
- 13.10 The use of drones by support person vessels is prohibited.
- 13.11 The movements of support person vessels will be restricted by the sailing instructions.

14. [DP] BERTHING

- 14.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park.

15. DATA PROTECTION AND MEDIA RIGHTS

- 15.1 With regards to data management, please refer to the Data Management Policies of the organizing authority.
- 15.2 By participating in this event competitors and their support persons automatically grant to the organizing authority and their sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the persons during the period of the competition without compensation.

16. RISK STATEMENT

- 16.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes

17. INSURANCE

- 17.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1.5 million EUR per incident or the equivalent.



18. PRIZES

18.1 For the 29er Euro Cup, the following prizes will be awarded:

- (a) Top 3 Male Boats,
- (b) Top 3 Female Boats,
- (c) Top 3 Mixed Boats,
- (d) Top U17 Male Boat (helm and crew born in 2008 or later),
- (e) Top U17 Female Boat (helm and crew born in 2008 or later), and
- (f) Top U17 Mixed Boat (helm and crew born in 2008 or later).

18.2 For the 2024 29er Hungarian Championship, the following prizes will be awarded:

- (a) Top 3 Boats Overall,
- (b) Top 3 U19 Boats (helm and crew born in 2006 or later),
- (c) Top U17 Boat (helm and crew born in 2008 or later), and
- (d) Top Female Boat.

18.3 For the Nacra 15 Ranking Regatta, the following prizes will be awarded:

- (a) Top 3 Boats overall, and
- (b) First Female Boat.
